### LATE KEITA GOAL LEADS TIMBERS IN DRAW WITH BATTERY:

Playing their third game in five days, a late equalizer by forward **Mandjou Keita** lifted the Portland Timbers to a come-from-behind 1-1 draw against the first-place Charleston Battery at Blackbaud Stadium on June 13. Down by a goal, Keita's header in the 84th minute secured the draw and extended the Timbers' unbeaten streak to 10 games in league play, matching a modern-franchise record set back in 2004. Keita

scored his third goal of the season, defender **Scot Thompson** logged his first assist to help the Timbers take sole possession of third place in the USL First Division. A late push by the Timbers allowed midfielder **Alex Nimo** to work around his man at the top right corner of the box and find Thompson on an overlapping run down the right touchline. Thompson then delivered a sharp cross into the center of the penalty area that connected with Keita at the top of the six-yard box. Keita out-jumped his defender and punched in the equalizer past Battery substitute goalkeeper Keith Wiggins.

**ON THE LINE:** The winner of tonight's second-round match between the Timbers and Sol will advance to the third round of the U.S. Open Cup and face Seattle Sounders FC of Major League Soccer. If the Timbers advance, Portland will play host to Seattle on Wednesday, July 1 at PGE Park at 7 p.m. If Sonoma County advances, they'll travel to face Seattle on June 30 at the Starfire Sports Complex.

**A 10 SPOT:** Portland's draw against Charleston last weekend extended its unbeaten streak in league play to 10 games (5-0-5), matching a modern-franchise mark previously set back in 2004. In 2004, the Timbers finished the season with a record of 7-0-3 over their final 10 matches from July 28-Aug. 29 to help secure the USL First Division regular-season championship.

**WHAT'S NEXT?** The Timbers return home and to USL First Division action Friday as they play host to the Minnesota Thunder at PGE Park at 8 p.m., live on Fox Soccer Channel. Friday's match features the Timbers' annual Teddy Bear Toss to benefit Doernbechers Children's Hospital. Tickets start at \$11 and can be purchased through the PGE Park box office, area Ticketmaster locations, online at [www.ticketmaster.com](http://www.ticketmaster.com) or by phone at (800) 745-3000.

## ABOUT PORTLAND TIMBERS

The Portland Timbers play their fourth consecutive match on the road Tuesday as they continue their run in the 2009 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup with a second-round match against the Sonoma County Sol of the U.S. Adult Soccer Association. Tuesday's game marks Portland's fourth match in the past week.

The Timbers opened their stretch of road games last week on June 9, in the first round of the U.S. Open Cup, defeating the Kitsap Pumas, one of four professional teams in the Premier Development League, 3-0 in Bremerton, Wash. Midfielder **Brian Farber**, forward **Jason McLaughlin** and defender **David Hayes** each scored in the second half and goalkeeper Steve Cronin recorded two saves in the shutout to help the Timbers advance in the tournament.

Portland then traveled to the east coast for matches against the Carolina RailHawks and Charleston Battery, the top two clubs in the USL First Division, and recorded a pair of draws, including a shutout, to extend it's unbeaten streak this season to 10 games in league play and 12 matches overall.

Over their last four matches, the Timbers have out-scored their opponents 5-1 and logged three shutouts. Portland's backline ranks among the USL First Division leaders in fewest goals allowed this season, having conceded just five goals through its first 11 matches of the season.

Earlier in the day, United Soccer Leagues announced that Hayes was named to the USL First Division Team of the Week for Week 10, for his performance in the Timbers' two-game road trip last week.

Following Tuesday's match, the Timbers play their next three matches at home, starting with Friday's contest against Minnesota. The Timbers will also play host to the Montreal Impact on June 28 and Germany's Bayern Munich II in a special international exhibition match at PGE Park on July 2.

\* Rookie midfielder **Josh Cameron** made his regular-season debut against Charleston on June 13, entering as a sub in the second half.

## ABOUT SONOMA COUNTY SOL:

Sonoma County, who competes in the National Premier Soccer League (NPSL), is the only U.S. Adult Soccer Association club remaining in the 2009 U.S. Open Cup. Like the Timbers, the Sol faces its second game in four days after a 1-1 draw against Real San Jose in league play over the weekend.

In the first round, the Sol defeated the Orange County Blue Star of the PDL 5-2 on the road to advance in the tournament. Sonoma County took a 1-0 lead at halftime, before exploding for four goals in the second half, including two from forward **Shawn Percell**. The Blue Star managed two score two goals after having a man sent off midway through the second stanza.

In 2009, the Sol is unbeaten through league play in the NPSL and in U.S. Open Cup matches and qualifiers, assembling a combined record of 11-0-3 and out-scoring their opponents 46-12. In first place in the West, Sonoma County has three more regular-season matches before starting the NPSL post season.

Led by head coach **Benjamin Ziemer**, the Sol feature 18 former NCAA Division I players, including three All-Americans, on its roster. Sonoma County also has two players with USL First Division experience in Percell (Seattle Sounders) and defender **Lee Sandwina** (Charleston Battery).

\* Percell played for the USL First Division Seattle Sounders for three seasons, while Sandwina was a member of the Battery in 2007. Percell also played professionally for one season in Belize.
