TIMBERS ADVANCE TO HOST MLS' SEATTLE SOUNDERS FC IN THIRD ROUND OF U.S. OPEN UP AT PGE PARK: With a 3-0 win over the Sonoma County Sol Tuesday, the Portland Timbers advanced to the third round of the 2009 U.S. Open Cup and will play host to Major League Soccer's Seattle Sounders FC on Wednesday, July 1 at PGE Park at 7 p.m. Forward **Mandjou Keita** logged two goals and an assist to lead the Timbers past the Sol, who compete in the U.S. Adult Soccer Association, in the second

round of the tournament at Santa Rosa High School in Santa Rosa, Calif. Forward **George Josten** put the Timbers ahead in the seventh minute. Keita then sealed the 3-0 victory late in the match with a pair of goals in the final 10 minutes of play. Goalkeeper **Steve Cronin** kept Sonoma County off the board for his second straight shutout in U.S. Open Cup play. The third-round matchup between the Timbers and Sounders FC will be the first official meeting between the Northwest rivals since Seattle joined MLS in 2009.

HAYES NAMED TO THE TEAM OF THE WEEK: United Soccer Leagues announced on Tuesday that Timbers defender **David Hayes** was selected to the USL First Division Team of the Week for Week 10.

A 10 SPOT: Portland's draw against Charleston last weekend extended its unbeaten streak in league play to 10 games (5-0-5), matching a modern-franchise mark previously set back in 2004. In 2004, the Timbers finished the season with a record of 7-0-3 over their final 10 matches from July 28-Aug. 29 to help secure the USL First Division regular-season championship.

WHAT'S NEXT? Following an eight-day break between games, the Timbers kick off a week of three games in five days on Sunday, June 28, against the Montreal Impact at PGE Park at 5 p.m. Tickets start at \$12, and are available through the PGE Park box office, area Ticketmaster locations, online at www.ticketmaster.com or by phone at (800) 745-3000. Portland then hosts the Seattle Sounders FC of MLS on Wed., July 1 in the third round of the U.S. Open Cup on Wednesday, July 1 and Germany's Bayern Munich II on Thursday, July 2 at PGE Park.

ABOUT PORTLAND TIMBERS

The Portland Timbers enter tonight's match against the Minnesota Thunder on a 10-game unbeaten streak in league play. The team's unbeaten streak matches a modern-franchise record set back in 2004. After four straight games on the road, the Timbers return home to PGE Park to host Minnesota - their fifth game in 11 days.

Portland currently sits in fourth place in the USL First Division, just four points back of the first-place Charleston Battery. In USL First Division action, the Timbers have out-scored their opponents 4-1 over their last four matches and have recorded three shutouts in that span. The Timbers backline ranks among league leaders in the fewest goals allowed this season, conceding just five in 11 matches.

On Tuesday, the Timbers defeated the Sonoma County Sol of the U.S. Adult Soccer Association 3-0 in Santa Rosa, Calif., in the second round of the U.S. Open Cup. Forward **Mandjou Keita** logged two goals and an assist in the match to lead Portland. With the victory, the Timbers advance to third round of the tournament and will play host to Major League Soccer's Seattle Sounders FC on July 1 at PGE Park at 7 p.m. Tickets, starting at \$12, went on sale to the public Thursday.

Portland is 10-5-11 all-time against Minnesota, including a 5-3-5 mark at PGE Park. Last season, the Timbers were 1-0-2 against the Thunder, including a 2-1 win at PGE Park on April 24, receiving goals from forward Chris Brown and midfielder **Shaun Higgins**. Portland is unbeaten against the Thunder over their last six meetings, five of which have ended in a draw. The Timbers have not lost a match to Minnesota since Aug. 4, 2006 - a 1-0 result.

The Timbers will be without the services of midfielders **Ryan Pore**, the team's leading scorer, and **Tony McManus**, defender **Takuro Nishimura** and forward **Antouman Jallow** for tonight's match due to injury.

Following tonight's match, the Timbers have an eight-day break between games. Portland will play host to the Montreal Impact on Sunday, June 28 at PGE Park as part of a special doubleheader with the Timbers U-23s beginning at 1 p.m. Kickoff against Montreal is set for 5 p.m. Tickets for either game are available through the PGE Park box office, area Ticketmaster outlets, online at www.ticketmaster.com or by phone at (800) 745-3000.

ABOUT MINNESOTA THUNDER:

The Minnesota Thunder make their lone trip to the Rose City to face the Portland Timbers tonight at PGE Park. Minnesota brings a three-game winning streak into tonight's match.

After starting the 2009 campaign on a nine-game winless stretch, the Thunder broke through for their first win of the season with a 3-2 victory in the first round of the U.S. Open Cup over U.S. Adult Soccer Association club 402 on June 9. Since then, the Thunder have logged two straight shut-out victories, including a 2-0 win over the Carolina RailHawks on June 14, and have out-scored opponents 6-0.

On Tuesday, the Thunder defeated the Chicago Fire of the Premier Development League 4-0 in the second round of the U.S. Open Cup at the National Sports Center. Forward **Melvin Tarley** scored twice and goalkeeper **Nic Platter** recorded seven saves to help Minnesota advance in the tournament. Minnesota will host the Kansas City Wizards of Major League Soccer on June 30 at the National Sports Center in Blaine, Minn.

Earlier this week, a pair of Thunder players were selected to the USL First Division Team of the Week for Week 10. Platter earned his second straight Team of the Week selection, while midfielder **Brian Cvilikas** was named Week 10's Player of the Week after scoring both goals in the team's win over Carolina.

According to team reports, midfield/defenders **Kevin Friedland** (hamstring) and **Rich Costanzo** (dislocated elbow) will be unavailable for tonight's match due to injuries.

Minnesota returns home to play host to the Rochester Rhinos on June 27 and then the Wizards on June 30 at the National Sports Center.
