KEITA'S BRACE LEADS TIMBERS TO 4-0 WIN OVER MONTREAL: Forward **Mandjou Keita** scored two goals and forward **George Josten** logged two assists to lead the Portland Timbers to a 4-0 win over the Montreal Impact before 7,783 at PGE Park on Sunday evening. The win pushes Portland's unbeaten streak to 12 matches in league play. Keita opened the scoring early in the match and then completed his brace early in the second half; he

has scored five goals over his last three matches. Defender **David Hayes** tallied an assist and midfielder **Brian Farber** also added his third goal of the season to lead Portland. Sunday's match marked just the fifth time in Impact history that the club surrendered four or more goals; Montreal is winless in Portland since 2006.

LAMAR HUNT U.S. OPEN CUP: The Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup, which is recognized as U.S. Soccer's national championship, is an annual competition open to all amateur and professional soccer teams affiliated with U.S. Soccer. The single-elimination tournament has crowned a champion for 95 consecutive years dating back to 1914.

ABOUT PORTLAND TIMBERS

The Portland Timbers enter tonight's U.S. Open Cup match against Major League Soccer's Seattle Sounders FC on a 15-game unbeaten streak (12 in league matches). The Timbers currently sit in third place in the USL First Division, just two points behind table leader the Puerto Rico Islanders.

With a 4-0 shutout victory over the Montreal Impact on Sunday at PGE Park, the Timbers extended their modern-franchise record unbeaten streak to 12 matches in league play and remain unbeaten at home this season (6-0-1). At PGE Park this season, the Timbers have out-scored their opponents 20-3 (seven league matches; one exhibition).

Led by goalkeeper **Steve Cronin**, Portland's defense has allowed just six goals in its first 13 games this season and paces the league in fewest goals allowed. On the other side of the field, the Timbers rank second in the league in scoring with 20 goals; six coming from forward **Mandjou Keita**.

The Timbers defeated the Kitsap Pumas (3-0) of the Premier Development League in the first round of the 2009 U.S. Open Cup and then eliminated the Sonoma County Sol (3-0) of the U.S. Adult Soccer Association in the second round to advance to tonight's match against Seattle. Including this season's run, the Timbers are 5-5-0 in U.S. Open Cup matches since joining United Soccer Leagues in 2001.

If Portland wins tonight's match, they will travel to face the Kansas City Wizards in the quarterfinal round scheduled for July 7.

Portland has advanced as far as the fourth round of the U.S. Open Cup, facing MLS' San Jose Earthquakes in both the 2004 and 2005 tournaments at PGE Park. The Timbers and Sounders have met in previous U.S. Open Cup tournaments. In 2005, the Timbers knocked Seattle out of the third round with a 2-0 win at PGE Park. Then in 2007, Seattle used a one-man advantage to overcome a one-goal deficit and defeat Portland 2-1 in a second-round matchup at Starfire Sport Complex. Timbers defender **Cameron Knowles** was issued a straight red card in that match, following a challenge with Sounders forward **Roger Levesque** on a ball in the air.

The spirited Portland-Seattle rivalry dates back to 1975, when both were members of the North American Soccer League. The Timbers were 11-16-5 against the Sounders in regular-season meetings in the USL First Division from 2001-08, and the two clubs split the all-time USL First Division series, 7-7-2, in games played in Portland. Last season, the Timbers were 1-1-1 against the Sounders, including a 2-0 win at PGE Park on April 26, 2008. This spring, the Timbers defeated the Sounders FC reserves 3-2 in a preseason contest on April 13, 2009 at Starfire Sports Complex.

Portland returns to league action on Saturday, July 4 against the Minnesota Thunder on the road. Kickoff is set for 5:05 p.m.

ABOUT SEATTLE SOUNDERS FC:

Seattle Sounders FC competes in its first U.S. Open Cup tournament as a member of Major League Soccer this season. Seattle is one of eight MLS teams that entered the tournament in the third round.

Sounders FC used two goals from forward **Nate Jaqua**, a native of Eugene, Ore., to capture a 3-0 win over the Colorado Rapids on Sunday in Seattle, Wash. With the win, the club extended its unbeaten streak to four games. Seattle has only suffered one loss in its last 10 matches. Sounders FC is in third place in the MLS Western Conference and sits only three points back of the first-place Houston Dynamo.

During the team's four-game unbeaten run, Seattle has out-scored opponents 9-5, with four of their nine goals coming in its last two matches. With one of the best goal differentials in MLS this season (+9), Sounders FC is 6-1-7 when goalkeeper **Kasey Keller** plays all 90 minutes between the sticks.

To enter the 2009 U.S. Open Cup, Sounders FC competed in a series of play-in matches to secure one of eight designated MLS spots in the tournament. Seattle defeated Real Salt Lake 4-1 on April 28, and Colorado 1-0, on May 26, to reach tonight's match in Portland. Forward **Sebastien Le Toux** recorded two goals and two assists in the team's two play-in matches.

If Seattle wins tonight's match, they will host the Kansas City Wizards in the quarterfinal round slated for July 7.

According to team reports, defender **Taylor Graham**, forward **Jarrod Smith** and goalkeeper Chris **Eylander** are still on the disabled list, while midfielder **Oswaldo Alonso** is out with a groin strain. Midfielder **Brad Evans** and defender **Tyrone Marshall** received call-ups from their respective National Teams for the upcoming CONCACAF Gold Cup and will be unavailable for tonight. Evans earns his first call to duty with the U.S. National Team while Marshall is expected to make his final appearances with Jamaica.

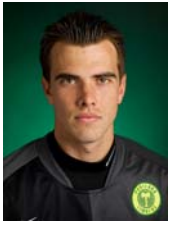
Sounders FC features several former USL First Division Seattle Sounders, including Eylander, Le Toux, forward **Roger Levesque**, goalkeeper **Ben Dragavon**, defenders Graham and **Zach Scott** and midfielder **Sanna Nyassi**. Of the group, Levesque has scored nine goals in matches against the Timbers from 2004-08, including five at PGE Park. He also scored all three goals in the Sounders' 2005 playoff series win over Portland in 2005.

Seattle returns to league play on July 11 when they play host to the Houston Dynamo at Xbox Pitch at Qwest Field in Seattle, Wash.

- * For. **Nate Jaqua**, from Eugene, Ore., was selected as the MLS Player of the Week following his performance against Colorado.
- * Mid. **Fredy Montero** has scored in four straight games for Seattle. He is tied for second in MLS scoring with eight goals and six assists.
- * Head coach **Sigi Schmid** has a 14-7-1 record in U.S. Open Cup matches as the head coach of MLS clubs. He led the Los Angeles Galaxy to the U.S. Open Cup championship in 2001.
- * Goalkeeper **Terry Boss** of Philomath, Ore., signed with Sounders FC on June 26. He was the 2008 USL Second Division Goalkeeper of the Year while with the Charlotte Eagles.
- * Seattle features two former University of Portland standouts in Jaqua and goalkeeper **Kasey Keller**.
- * Both Levesque and Nyassi have played for the Portland Timbers as guest players in recent years. In 2007, Levesque suited up for Portland in an exhibition against Toronto FC at PGE Park, while Nyassi scored a goal for the Timbers in an exhibition against Mexican Primera Division club Monarcas Morelia last season.

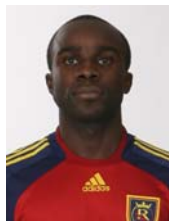
